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1. Introduction

The St. John's Port Authority (SJPA) was established pursuant to the *Canada Marine Act* (CMA), which received Royal Assent on May 1, 1999. The CMA repealed the Canada Ports Corporation Act of 1983.

The SJPA's mission is to provide consistently valuable, innovative, and efficient port services that foster trade, regional growth, and provincial success.

The purpose of the *Privacy Act* is to extend the present laws of Canada that protect the privacy of individuals with respect to personal information about themselves held by a government institution and that provide individuals with a right of access to that information.

This report is prepared in accordance with section 72 of the *Privacy Act* and the annual reports are tabled in Parliament in accordance with section 72 of the *Act*.

This report covers the fiscal year 2024-04-01 to 2025-03-31. There were no *Privacy Act* requests received during that period.

The SJPA did not have any non-operational subsidiaries during this reporting period.

2. Organizational Structure of the Access to Information Privacy Office

The responsibility for processing requests received under the *Privacy Act* rests with the President and Chief Executive Officer, who ensures compliance with the legislation.

Administration of the *Privacy Act* - the staff complement at the SJPA is 14. The President and CEO is the *Privacy Act* Coordinator, there is one representative and one officer. Procedures for handling *Privacy Act* requests are well known throughout our institution.

The SJPA did not enter into any agreements under section 73.1 of the *Privacy Act* during this reporting period.

3. Delegation Order

The *Privacy Act* Coordinator is the President and Chief Executive Officer, Mr. Sean Hanrahan, who is the head of our institution. There has been no further delegation setting out the powers, duties and functions for the administration of the *Privacy Act*. The

President and CEO ensures that any requests are processed in accordance with the provisions of the *Act*.

4. Performance

The SJPA did not receive any requests during the period 2024-04-01 to 2025-03-31.

Given that there were never any *Privacy Act* requests received at the SJPA, no identifiable trends have been established.

5. Training and Awareness

There were no initiatives or projects undertaken in the year. Improvement reviews around privacy are conducted on an ongoing basis, as needed.

The SJPA did not receive any requests under the *Privacy Act* and did not complete any PIAs during this reporting period.

11. Public Interest Disclosures
